



Jill Olson is called to serve as loan officer/office specialist for Church of the Brethren Credit Union

Oct. 30, 2008, Elgin, Ill. — Jill Olson has been called to serve Church of the Brethren Benefit Trust in the newly created position of loan officer/office specialist for Church of the Brethren Credit Union, effective Nov. 10.

Jill, who with her husband, Scott, recently relocated to Illinois from Fishers, Ind., formerly worked as senior account manager for Wesleyan Investment Foundation, where she served on the firm's senior management team. In her role, she managed all transactions and processes for its savings/IRA accounts, developed policies and procedures, managed and audited accounts, managed databases, worked closely with the administration of loans, and was responsible for ACH transactions and deposits.

In her role with Church of the Brethren Credit Union, Jill will serve as loan officer and will assist with customer service needs. She will support the director in the creation and implementation of policies and procedures, assist with administrative duties related to the Board of Directors, and work with product development, marketing, promotion, interpretation, and field-visit initiatives.

“We are excited to welcome Jill to the Church of the Brethren Benefit Trust staff as a member of the Church of the Brethren Credit Union team,” said Nevin Dulabaum, BBT president. “Her experience of working with savings and loans and IRAs for a faith-based organization that has served a national clientele will bring much-needed support and leadership to the Credit Union.”

With her hiring, Jill will become the Credit Union's third dedicated staff member. She will join Director Steve Bob, who begins his CoBCU tenure on Nov. 3, and Connie Sandman, who has served as the Credit Union's member services representative since April 2004. The Credit Union is also supported by other BBT personnel who assist with finance, human resources, marketing and promotion, editorial, information technology, and general office tasks.
